<p>Define the main teaching objectives for the pupils</p>	
<b>Resources</b>	
<p>Quote Internet sites, texts to be read, worksheets, etc. which will be resources for the pupils</p>	
<b>Preparations</b>	
<p>Describe what preparations should be done beforehand, by the teacher and/or the pupils</p>	
<b>Plan of Lessons</b>	
<p>Suggest learning activities, procedures and timing. Be brief or give details. It is desirable to receive ideas for differential education</p>	
<b>Debriefing and Assessment</b>	
<p>K06 stresses the importance of raising pupils' awareness and ability to reflect upon their own learning. If you have ideas for how pupils can be involved in this</p>	

process, please contribute (self-assessment, peer-to-peer assessment, assessment for learning/assessment of learning)	
<b>F</b> ollow-up	
If possible, give suggestions for extension of the work	
<b>C</b> omments	
If possible, briefly reflect on the process of carrying out the teaching plan; pupils' comments are also appreciated
